I live in a four-story apartment house. My antenna is 9m long wire along a 10m glass fiber pole. SGC SG-230 auto-tuner is

used to tune to an operation frequency. I can operate from 80m to 10m bands with this antenna. When thunder or strong wind come, I often shorten the pole to remove the fear neighbor may feel. Neighbors' view is an obstacle to enjoy ham radio.

My rig is TS-870S. I am permitted to use output power of 100W. But usually I operate with a power of 50W to reduce the risk of RF interfere to neighbor. I use a Bencher JA-1 paddle, a GHD GN207A bug key, and a HI-MOUND HK-702 straight key. My FISTS membership certificate is put on a wall. Two mottoes "Accuracy Transcends Speed" and "Courtesy at All Times" printed on the certificate always make me check my operation. I like these mottoes.
